Code of Conduct

Rules

- Admission will be £1 per session (refreshments extra). All profit from the admission charge and tuck shop will go back to the Group.
- Youth Group is only open to St James' and St Swithun's parishioners currently in Years 7, 8, and 9 in secondary school.
- The Group operates a zero tolerance policy in respect of bad behaviour.
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere in the church hall or gardens.
- Alcohol, drugs and weapons are strictly forbidden.
- All young people are expected to remain for the duration of the session, unless the leaders have been advised otherwise by a parent/guardian.
- There is a strict 'no guest' rule.

These rules are non negotiable. If any are broken, the young person may be excluded from the Group.

Code

- All young people are expected to be courteous and to act in a way that will ensure a safe and supportive environment for all.
- All young people are expected to respect and care for each other and each other's property, and the property and equipment of the Group.
- Please respect all areas of the church hall and gardens. Do not drop litter or cause damage.
- Mobile phones must be on silent or vibrate during the sessions.
- All young people must remain in the church hall or gardens, unless accompanied by an adult. If a young person does leave the premises without permission, it will be at their own risk and not the responsibility of the Group leaders.
